
Environment

The Sanctuary will provide an environment of nurture and safety, helping reduce the stress levels placed on the child and enabling them to be able to

fully engage in learning. We will then use our therapeutic approach in every interaction to build strong personal relationships, helping our children feel both listened to and accepted unconditionally.

Using this strong connection, we can help our students co-regulate their emotions assisting them to build new positive behaviour which they can use to regain control of their emotions. Then, by praising positive behaviours and listening non judgementally, we can help students gain a deeper understanding of their emotions and feeling, enabling them to not act using previous behaviours but using past experiences to respond.

The Sanctuary therapeutic offer uses a combination of approaches to meet the diverse needs of each child.

Individual therapeutic support within the Sanctuary will be developed by Trinity's Multidisciplinary Therapeutic Team. Using the information gathered during the consultation, this team will create an individual training and therapeutic plan which has been developed to best meet the child's needs.

Firstly, the focus will be on helping the child and their parents and caregivers settle into the new learning environment. Through the use of attachment play and positive interactions using our nurturing approach, we can create trusting relationships helping develop a sense of safety. We will build a team around the child of strong attachment figures, ensuring they always have someone to go to in times of need.

From here, we can start the process of focus therapeutic work by our on-site psychotherapeutic counsellor, as well as integrate sensory and healing activities into the daily timetable. This integrated approach allows for staff in the Sanctuary to work together to drive forward healthy progress.

Our therapeutic approach will use a range of resources at our disposal to fully explore, understand and support our children's needs. These include narrative play, sand tray, trauma focus cognitive behavioural therapy, bibliotherapy and the use of virtual reality. Also, we will work with external services when needed to provide the additional support our children may require. Our centre is designed to work collaboratively with all agencies to provide the best service possible. We aim to help all our children integrate fully into society and education. To help this, once the challenges and needs have been addressed, we will develop a process to support the transition for the child's next steps. This will involve a "toolkit" for both the child and any others involved to best prepare everyone for the future.

Our educational package is shaped around the children's strengths and ambitions. As English and Maths is essential to all, we use CENTURY Tech, an advanced online learning system that develops an individual programme suited to your child. This online system can be accessed 24/7 enabling your child the ability to access education even if they can't access the building.

Linking in with our Trust's strong vocational background, we will source internally or externally, programmes that both highlight your child's strengths and can help them progress towards their goals.

All bespoke plans at the Sanctuary will be unique to each child and designed together with the Parents, caregivers, and all others involved in supporting that child's journey.







Parent and caregiver

As part of our drive to support your child's needs, the Sanctuary can offer further support to the families, helping us all work together effectively. Using the elements of Theraplay, combined with our understanding of attachment and childhood development, our BRAVE parenting programme can help parents and caregivers learn more about what drives their child's behaviour. This non-judgmental and inclusive training aims to provide parents and caregivers not only skills and knowledge to support challenging behaviour but to build a sense of self-compassion for themselves. Also, these programmes aim to build a network of parents and caregivers that can offer mutual support and guidance, helping everyone realise they are not alone in facing these challenges.
